General Use Instructions:

Used at a concentration of 1.0-5.0% depending on the soil load of the surface or equipment to be cleaned or apply as is for very stubborn and hard to remove soil.

FOR WATER CHLORINATION

- 1. Pre-clean the surface if necessary, to remove gross-soil particles
- 2. Prepare a solution of LINOL® (1.0-5.0%). Preferably warm
- 3. Soak the items and allow contact time
- 4. Agitate the surfaces by scrubbing, brushing or wiping
- 5. Rinse thoroughly
- 6. Sanitize all food-contact areas
- 7. Air dry
